Entries will be accepted **only through Dogshow.ca**

Entries open Wednesday, July 29th, 2026 at 9:00 pm and close Friday, August 21st, 2026 at 9:00 p.m.



A service charge of 5% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online, by fax or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

All entries must be submitted through DogShow.ca and received **BEFORE** the Closing date to be accepted.

If, at closing, fewer than 8 dogs have entered the WC/WCI/WCX test the Labrador Owners Club may cancel the test (WC rule 2.3.1(b)). In such a case all entrants will be notified immediately after closing.

- **IF THE TEST IS FULL BEFORE CLOSING:** You can have your entry held on a wait list.
- **WAITLIST ENTRY:** will be through Dogshow.ca

TEST DETAILS:

- Standard CKC rosettes awarded to all qualifying dogs
- Ribbons will be given out at the conclusion of each test.
- Ducks will be used
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used
- Handlers should not wear distinctive white or light clothing except that handlers may wear handling jackets for blinds in WCX.
- Refunds will be given for bitches in season. A Veterinarian certificate must be submitted prior to test
- Running order is by random draw within each test level
- Recommended arrival time is ½ hour prior to the start time for each stake.



CKC Rules & Regulation for Working Certificate Tests (section 14.7)

14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignity. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC and infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

It is the expectation of the Labrador Owners Club that every entrant will take the time to review the CKC Rules for the Working Certificate Tests prior to start of the test.

Due the difficulties in obtaining volunteers gunners, handlers may be asked to help out and gun.

By entering this test I CERTIFY that I am the registered owner(s) of the dog or that I am the authorized agent of the owner(s) whose name(s) I have entered above and accept full responsibility for all statements made in this entry. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of The Canadian Kennel Club and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list.

Since 2017, The Pinebank Challenge has been a great opportunity for LOC members and their Labrador(s) to take part in the wide variety of dog events offered by the Club each year. Starting with Obedience / Rally in January and ending with Tracking in October, you are encouraged to enter as many events as you are able! The more you enter the greater your chance of finishing in the top 4!

The Pinebank awards are presented at the Annual General Meeting in November. Cash awards are presented to the Top 4 Dog & Owner/Handlers Teams. First \$100, Second \$75, Third \$50, Fourth \$25. Susie Bell, Pinebank Kennels, has also graciously donated a trophy for the Challenge Winner. In a tie situation each participant with the same # of points is awarded the cash prize amount.
