- Meeting invitations will be forwarded to all entrants that include an email address.
- There will be no Worker Draw.

Limit of Entries: 3 TD and 2 TDX tracks OR as permitted by available land and to a combined maximum of 7 units, where each TD equals 1 unit and each TDX equals two units.

Bitches in season: Bitches in season will be permitted to compete but will be assigned the last track. Notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season on the day of the test. All dogs must be always kept on leash and under control.



Prizes: A Rosette will be awarded to every successful participant.

Entry fees: (HST included LOC HST #891772485) **TD \$90 TDX \$125 TCN: \$11.13**

Non-Member Participation Fee: A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. For the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

Entry Information

- All entries must be on an official CKC entry form.
- All Tracking titles earned by the dog must be listed.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of who completes the entry form.
- Incomplete or improper entry forms will not be accepted.
- Include all relevant titles on the entry form.
- Entries may be accepted by email sent to jc6vd6@gmail.com,
- Send entry fee, **NOT BEFORE March 23, 2026**, via e-transfer to: labradorownersclub3@gmail.com Answer to the security question: **trackingtest**
- E-transfers will be accepted only from entrants who are successfully drawn at the Draw for Entry on April 21, 2026
- Entries with cheques may be mailed, hand delivered or sent by courier to the postal address of the Test Secretary.
- Mail or courier deliveries must not require a signature for delivery
- Multiple entries in one envelope will be accepted but **each entry must have a separate cheque or money order.**
- Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee.
- **POST DATED CHEQUES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**
- A TCN fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog with a Canadian Kennel Club Individual Registration Number or Event Registration Number
 - **N.S.F. Cheques:** There will be a \$30.00 charge for N.S.F. cheques
 - **Temporary Competition Fee:** A Temporary Competition fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

- All other entry requirements including ERN, PEN, MCN, CCN, TCN may be reviewed in the Tracking Test Rules and Regulations Effective January 1, 2026 Section 6
- Food and drink will **not** be available at the test site

Attention foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.

Confirmation of Entry: All entries will be acknowledged when they are received and an invitation to join the entry draw via WEBEX will be issued. Placement in the test or on the alternate list will be confirmed after the Entry Draw on April 21, 2026. Only written withdrawals received on or before **May 7, 2026** will be accepted.

Alternate List: When the advised limit has been reached all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on an "Alternate List" in the order they are drawn in the Entry Draw after closing.

- At the time of the draw for tracks on test day, any entries from the alternate list may fill any absentee spaces.
 - The person making the entry shall be notified of their position on the Alternate list. Entries will be refunded within ten days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test.

The Track Draw for TD: Will take place in or near the Training Hall at Glen Crieff Trial Headquarters on Friday, May 8, 2026 at 9am. Grounds open at 8am. TD Tests will start at 9:30am, followed by TDXs. **The Track Draw for TDX** will take place in or near the Training Hall at Glencrieff Trial Headquarters on Friday, May 8, 2026 **at a time to be announced after closing.**

The Labrador Owners Club has ZERO tolerance for abuse (or harsh handling) of any kind, to any person or animal present at any of our events. This includes, but is not limited to, judges, organizers, volunteers, competitors, animals and members of the public.

Failure to comply could result in immediate removal from the event and the site, up to and including a permanent ban from any and all future Labrador Owners Club events. The decision to remove from an event is at the discretion of the LOC event organizers present, in consultation with members of the LOC Executive. A permanent ban will be determined after a thorough review of the incident by the LOC Executive. The person under review will be advised of the final decision upon completion of the review.
